



Marble Carrara

Carrara marble is a natural material, that will add an extra spark and exclusivity to your outdoor kitchen design. When properly maintained it will last a lifetime.

To achieve the highest quality products and premium design levels, we work solely with Bianco Carrara C honed, one of the finest and most characteristic types of Carrara.

Each piece of Carrara marble has its specific appearance in terms of colors and pattern. Therefore, please note that images and photos will not do Carrara marble justice.

Normal care

Carrara marble is a porous material sensitive to acidic and colored liquids and high temperatures. Fluids, with low pH and/or color, such as wine, citrus or other sour substances may leave marks and stains. Matter from fish or meat can also stain the surface.

- Always use a coaster under glasses and potholders for warm pots and pans.
- Any fluid or stain should immediately be wiped clean to reduce the risk of permanent damage.
- After every use, clean your Carrara carefully with a fine cloth and soft soap water with a neutral pH level. Preferably, use only detergent products specifically made for marble.

Maintenance

Carrara marble is an exclusive nature material that needs special care to maintain its qualities.

- Before taking it into use, polish it thoroughly using marble oil.
- Polish the stone with marble oil regularly throughout the year to protect the surface and keep its beautiful finish.
- Always keep the marble in temperatures above 10°C/50°F to reduce the risk of cracks.

Important!

- Do not store marble outdoors in cold weather. At low temperatures, it may crack. Always keep it inside when temperatures are below 10°C/50°F.
- Do not place hot pots or pans directly onto the marble. High temperatures can cause the marble to crack.
- Marble is sensitive to acidic and colored substances such as sour liquids, sauces, and foods like fish and meat. Make sure to wipe the surface clean immediately after each use to keep it in mint condition.

Warranty

The warranty cover manufacturing defects, obvious design flaws and surface imperfections. Some of our products are untreated and will develop a natural patina after some time in use. This is perfectly normal and is not covered by warranty. We recommend using our custom-made Luxury Covers for optimal protection. To avoid mold and other damages related to a damp environment, we strongly recommend placing something in between the product and the cover for maximum air circulation.
